Here are some tips to find out what's happening during an emergency at WSU.

- ✓ **Sign up** for [Campus E-Alert](#) to receive e-mail and telephone information during campus emergencies.
- ✓ **Sign up** for [MyFacilities Event Notifications](#) to be notified of construction and maintenance work which may impact you.
- ✓ **Follow** @WSUAlert on Twitter to receive WSU emergency information.
- ✓ **Call** 911 to notify WSU Police of emergencies.
- ✓ **Call** 509-335-8548 for WSU Police non-emergency assistance or response.
- ✓ **Call** 509-335-3041 to contact Environmental Health & Safety about non-emergency safety concerns.
- ✓ **Call** 509-335-9000 to contact Facilities Services about facilities-related concerns.
